Preface

The essence of Dominionist dogma can be summarized as follows: **It is the responsibility of Christians in the Church Age to usher in the Kingdom of God on earth. Once Christians systematically establish this Kingdom, then and only then, will the Lord Jesus Christ return to earth.** What is the source of this fantasy? Not the Word of God! Nowhere does Scripture present such a reversal of the prophetic chronology. My conclusion is that this fabrication is nothing more than a figment of the Dominionist's vain imagination; supported by some of the most blatant interpretive distortions of God's Word you will ever encounter.

My recent exposure to and interaction with Dominion Theology has not only left me appalled, but profoundly concerned for the spiritual condition of Evangelical Christianity in the United States, and throughout the world. Dominion Theology takes the Word of God and turns it upside down, on its ear. It is a distortion designed for the purpose of accomplishing an end time deception. As a result, my approach will be to simplify this doctrinal complication, in order to clarify the massive amount of confusion being imposed upon so many unsuspecting Christians. With that in mind, the positive theme of this study will be expressed as:

The Kingdom of God on Earth: Past/Present/Future.

I will not be engaging in verbal debates with the proponents of this false teaching, but will do my best to provide an exegetical presentation of relevant Scripture, in order to overturn the undermining effect which Dominion Theology has had upon the purpose of God in these last days.
