

The Remnant Reformation Declaration

Article One:

In signing this declaration, I affirm the sound doctrine of the historic, Evangelical Christian faith, as confirmed in 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, as well as Jude 3 – “. . . the faith which was once for all handed down to the saints.”

Article Two:

In signing this declaration, I affirm that the apostolic era is over. Its sign gifts served the purpose of laying down the foundation for the building of Christ's Church, as confirmed in Ephesians 2:19-22 and Hebrews 2:3-4.

Article Three:

In signing this declaration, I affirm that the methodology for advancing the cause of Christ in our world is the Great Commission, as confirmed in Matthew 28:18-20.

Article Four:

In signing this declaration, I renounce the methodology of political activism for furthering the cause of Christ anywhere in our world, in that it is a weapon of the flesh and not the Spirit (2 Corinthians 10:3-4; Ephesians 6:17b). In addition, I reject secular psychology as a means to Christian growth and development, in that it is an elementary principle of the world and not of Christ (Colossians 2:6-8).

Article Five:

In signing this declaration, I affirm the priority of my citizenship in the kingdom of heaven, engaging in spiritual warfare in a manner that is in harmony with those principles, as confirmed in John 18:36; Philippians 3:17-21 and Ephesians 6:18-20.

Article Six:

In signing this declaration, I utterly renounce the idolatrous cult surrounding Donald Trump and steadfastly refuse to bow my knee to this modern-day Baal.

Article Seven:

In signing this declaration, I promise to present this commitment to the pastor of my local church; knowing what this may mean for any continued involvement in that fellowship, as indicated in 2 Corinthians 6:17-18 and Revelation 18:4-5.
